2018 PCLGA Luncheon Meeting

August 23, 2018

## WELCOME:

The meeting was begun by President Norma Colosimo, who welcomed everyone to Sue Seeman's home, at 2:25 pm. 31 members were in attendance. Sue was thanked for graciously hosting us at her home and presented with a gift from the members by Kate LaBelle.

Norma thanked all the officers, committee chairs and volunteers who donated their time and talents over the recent few years during a time of many changes. She asked for the Board ... Kate LaBelle (Vice President), Lori Myers and Diane Bishop (Tournament Chairs), Madelyn Stevens (Treasurer) and Susan Odneal (Secretary, not present) ... to stand for recognition. She gave a special acknowledgement to Lori Myers and Pole Creek Pro, JT Thompson who have taken considerable extra time to learn the new software program, Golf Genius, we are using. Norma also recognized Mary Moynihan for all her *behind the scenes* support and Mary was presented with a gift from the members by Kate Labelle.

Finally, Norma introduced new members who were at the luncheon: Nancy Carmack, Kerri Lambert, Kris Ramer, Kathy Rife and Linda Wenzak-Barth.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Norma announced the Board's decision to increase Play of the Day and Tournament winnings subsequent to discussion at the July meeting regarding league monies. Norma updated us on plans for our annual donation to Pole Creek, saying that last year's donation (not made) and this year's would be combined to and given to Craig's maintenance team to buy 4 new tools for the mowers. She acknowledged Craig's hard work on keeping the greens alive through a harsh winter. Jeanne Anne MacDonald relayed discussions she's had with Pole Creek about Memorial Plaques honoring deceased members of the league and asked for input from the group regarding style and placement indicating that she would like to conclude this project by the end of this season. Maggy Helm suggested that as long as monies were available, the league give Sky Hi News a small gift and note of appreciation for the effort they take to get league announcements in the paper.

NEW BUSINESS:

The volunteer sheet was circulated and Norma told us that there are openings on the Handicap, Championship Luncheon, Invitational and New Members Committees.

Norma relayed important information regarding handicapping and why it is important that we have several members who learn and understand the Handicap system. The USGA is changing to world rules in 2020. When the change occurs, we will have to have a number of members take and pass a Handicap course given by the CGA at their annual meeting, in order for us to keep using the GHIN system. We have a few members attending the annual CGA meeting, Saturday March 9<sup>th</sup> next year, but there is always room for more. Anyone interested can go to the USGA's website and begin reading their Handicap Manual. There will be classes, but no testing in 2019 because of the changes in 2020.

The Rules of Golf will be changing next year, too, and our Rules Chairman, Pat Riddell, is planning to attend the Rules class at the annual meeting. Additional members are encouraged to attend with Pat.

Kris Ramer asked about sharing ideas she and others might have. Lori reported that the Tournament Chairs would be sending out a survey near the 1<sup>st</sup> of September seeking member input on weekly games, etc.
