

## Minutes of Mid-Season Pole Creek Ladies Golf Meeting of July 19, 2018

Meeting was called to order by Norma Colosimo. Madelyne Stevens reported that we have \$5,500 in the reserve fund. It was started with \$4,000 in it and has continued to grow as it's not been used. A discussion ensued regarding use of it. There were several ideas shared with how we might use some of it. A motion was made by Sue Brooks, seconded by Gigi Dominguez and unanimously supported to create a survey that would go to the membership to determine the best use of some of the funds. The Board will determine the top options and then the survey created and sent out to the entire membership.

Additionally, Madelyne reported that we did not donate \$250 to Pole Creek last year and will donate \$500 to cover both 2017 and 2018 after this season. It was discussed that we will determine what the best use of the \$500 will be (after discussions with the staff). Details on this discussion will be shared with the league.

Lori Myers reported that the Handicap lead is Janet Conneely. Sue Seeman is still part of the group but asked that someone else take the lead due to multiple commitments. Lori encouraged all to read the manual, learn more about handicaps and that Janet is looking for another person to be a part of the Handicap group. Please let Janet know if you are interested.

Lori also mentioned that Golfgenius.com is helping correct math errors on the scorecards and is automatically calculating adjustments necessary to keep the scoring correct. Further, the online tool will automatically post for all players. NO need to post when you play on Thursdays.

Finally, she mentioned that if you are playing in the Club Championship you only have to sign up for the Wednesday/Thursday option on golfgenius. DO NOT sign up for Wed/Thursday and then for Thursday play. Thursday play option is ONLY for those who are playing Thursday ONLY. Please take a moment and check it out online.

Norma reported that pace of play is a challenge again. Please keep up with the group in front of you. We have a local 'rule' that you may walk off the putting clock and move forward while two other players in your group remain behind and finish putting. We do this to keep play moving forward. "Ready golf".

We will have 2019 Volunteer Opportunities document available online and at the check in table in mid-August. Be thinking of the role you'd like to play in 2019.
