

## Pole Creek Ladies Golf Membership Meeting

August 27, 2020

Meeting called to order by Lori Myers, President. She welcomed the over 30 members to our first outdoor meeting after the Club Championship at Wolf Park. Everyone social distanced via their own chairs. Lori reported that this was a most interesting year. We had deaths, surgeries and good times all rolled into one during the pandemic. Diane delivered a special gift to Cindy "17" Moynahan as she scored that lovely number on Meadow #7 during this year's tournament. She thanked Diane Bishop, VP for her leadership over the past 6 years and presented her with a gift of a ball marker/green repair tool. Mary Brooks will assume that position next year. Her assignment, presently, is to get the Club Championship plaque engraved (Lori Myers 2019 and our new champion this year...see below). Lori also presented a gift to Madelyne Stevens, outgoing Treasurer, who has been in this capacity for the last 6 years. She, too, received a ball mark/green repair tool.

Diane Bishop, VP thanked Beth Daniel for her hosting of this year's 'Happy Hour and Awards'. She was thanked by all in attendance via a round of applause.

Susan Odneal reported that the website is always looking for updates and any suggestions to improve the site. Lori mentioned that all committee chairman should review the website sections that pertain to their areas and provide Susan will updates that she will post.

Additionally, it was reported that a SurveyMonkey will be sent to all members that seeks input on suggestions for 2021. Questions about games and tee times vs. shotgun will be included. It was announced that we will continue to have all interested putt/chip-in pot participants to join in the beginning of the season via a 'one time fee' that will allow players to participate in it throughout the season. Dar mentioned "no more need for \$2 each Thursday, it'll be a part of the game for those who choose to join" and reporting will continue via text messaging to Dar Klancke.

Madelyne Stevens, Treasurer, officially handed over the 'books' to Rose Reed as Treasurer.

Rules Committee reported that they were hopeful the weekly "So You Think You Know the Rules?" episodes have been helpful. The membership agreed. If anyone has suggestions, please let Pat Riddell know. It was brought forward that the bunkers should be following the USGA Covid suggestions (free drop out of footprints but still in the bunkers) and it was decided that members should contact Pat Riddell with their concerns. They will let her know.

Maggy Helm reported that Publicity does occur by Monday of every week to the SkyHi News but the last three weeks have not had any mention of the information she has provided. She's 'at the mercy' of what the paper decides to print. She'll keep at it and include the picture as well as write up of our Club Championship.

Helen Brown, Linda Seale & Kerri Lambert were the new member team. Kerri welcomed all our new members and they introduced themselves. Welcome to all!

Lori Myers reported that our donation of \$270 to the club will be designated to the course maintenance team to purchase three new ball mark repair tool for their machines (one for each nine) per Craig's comments on what might be the most needed.

Thanks were shared to Mary Moynihan, Craig and JT for a great season. Gifts will be delivered to them.

Lori Myers then introduced the slate of officers for a two-year term, 2021-2022, per our Bylaws based on the Nominating Committee of the Board. President, Lori Myers; VP Mary Brooks; Secretary Susan Odneal; Treasurer Rose Reed; Tournament Chairman Cindy Moynahan; Asst. Tournament Chairman Linda Moore. The membership voted to accept this slate unanimously. Tournament Chairman in Training is a non-officer position and Mary Byerrum accepted this position. Additionally, Madelyne Stevens will be Asst. Treasurer and Marie Johannes will be Asst. Secretary (both non-officer positions as well).

Hole in Ones were recognized: Sue Seeman and Jeanne Nicoulin.

Julie Richards (on behalf of Jeanne Anne MacDonald) reported that there were 77 birdies made by 32 golfers. That's up 17 from 2019. On July 30, 13 birdies (the most for one day) were recorded. The fewest birdies were recorded (4) on July 2 & July 23. Most birdies were recorded on Meadow #4 (19). Birdie Towels were distributed to all 'birdie' makers during Thursday play. Highest number of birdies (7) was recorded by Janet Conneely.
