Minutes of the End of Season Meeting

August 26, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 3:30pm by Lori Myers, President. She welcomed everyone and commented on the great year we had together. She thanked everyone for their participation and highlighted the importance of everyone helping out since we're a 100% volunteer organization. Signup sheet was passed for open volunteer positions. (And all positions were filled!).

Mary Brooks, outgoing VP commented on her role and shared that she doesn't wish to be President next year (the customary role of the VP in year 2). She, instead, will be part of other committees and has enjoyed her time as part of the tournament team and VP. Thanks to Mary for a great job!

Rose Reed, Treasurer, reported that we have \$5940 in the bank. Club championship prize money \$475 and match play \$140 will reduce the balance. September winnings are budgeted at \$620. Other prize money and expenses will range from \$200-300. It's anticipated that the remaining balance, about \$4400 will be in our account at year end. We have maintained about \$5400 in the account for the last 10 years. We are spending old money at a rate of about \$1000 per year in extra prize money/expenses. We will reassess our spending each year as the balance draws down. She also reported that we have 51 members with all but 7 in the putt/chip in pot.

Lori reported that next year when completing Registration it will include prize money payouts, GHIN, and Hole in One Insurance. This is a simpler way to sign up each year (not so many confusing boxes). Match Play and Putt/Chip In pots will be separate and optional.

Website team (Susan Odneal) asked that all members let her or Helen Brown know if you have issues or see anything that should be changed (or added).

New member team welcomed our new members from 2020 and 2021. Round of applause.

Group thanked Cindy Moynahan for her tenure (ending) as tournament chairman. Great job!

Officer election was held. There were no additional names to be added to any of the leadership so a vote was taken. All agreed on the 2022 officers (Lori Myers, President; Madelyne Steven, VP; Rose Reed, Treasurer; Susan Odneal, Secretary; Linda Moore, Tournament Chair; Mary Byerrum, Asst Tournament Chair. Additionally, the Tournament Chairman in Training is Pat Wischmann, Helen Brown is Asst. Secretary and the Asst Treasurer position is open (but later filled by Pam Buderus).

Mary Moynihan was thanked for her help at Pole Creek. She shared comments about doing whatever the group wants (tee times, shotgun, etc). JT and Craig also were thanked and gifts given to them from the group.

It was determined that we would evaluate the tee times/shotgun starts in the Spring for the 2022 season.

Thanks went out to Jeanne Anne MacDonald and Kathy Kopp for handling the maintenance crew luncheons.

Kris Ramer commented that she would like to add another committee to our roster. The "social committee" who would begin a Facebook page for our group, organize social events throughout the

year (aside from golf) and open it up to any member of our group that wants to join in the event. All in attendance agreed! It was decided that she will also be using GolfGenius as a format to communicate with all members (since not all are on social media). It will also allow people to sign up for events. Kerri Lambert volunteered to assist Kris in this new group.

The awards for 2021 season were then given out. (\$s next to the winners is the amount won in pro shop 'dollars')

During her comments on the Handicap Committee, Janet Conneely awarded the Most Improved Golfers (field divided into two flights):
